COVID-19 VACCINATION ROLL-OUT

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO REGISTER FOR AND RECEIVE A VACCINE?

AS OF FRIDAY, 20TH AUGUST 2021, ALL PEOPLE 18
YEARS AND OLDER ARE ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION AND
VACCINATION.

PRIORITISATION OF HIGH-RISK GROUPS

The following people will continue to be prioritised for vaccination, in the following order:

- people over 60 years of age and people with disabilities;
- people who are scheduled (have appointments) to be vaccinated on a particular day; and
- people between 50 and 59 years of age.

Anyone **over the age of 50** is encouraged not to wait for a scheduled appointment, but to present as a walk-in at any vaccination site.

All vaccination sites must make every effort to vaccinate people over 50. Where insufficient vaccines are available, they should be registered and provided with assistance to be vaccinated as soon as possible.

HIGH RISK GROUPS

People belonging to high-risk groups who are older than 18 should be vaccinated as soon as possible.

High risk groups include:

- transplant recipients;
- people on immunosuppressant therapy; and
- people with other co-morbidities.









WHAT DOCUMENTS DO I NEED TO REGISTER?

The following documents can be used for registration:

- South African ID documents (green book, ID smartcard or birth certificate with ID number);
- foreign passport; or
- refugee or asylum seeker number.

WHAT IF I AM UNDOCUMENTED?

A solution which will allow undocumented people (both South Africans and foreign nationals) to be vaccinated using their Health Patient Registration System (HPRS) number is currently being developed and is expected to be available from October 2021.
